NO.SO (TR-I)1-4/2025 (NEV): In pursuance of the approval of the Punjab New Energy Vehicle (NEV) Policy, 2026 by the Provincial Cabinet in its 34th meeting held on 11.05.2026, the Competent Authority has been pleased to notify and circulate the approved Policy for its operationalization and subsequent implementation across the Province.

2. The Punjab NEV Policy, 2026 has been formulated to promote clean mobility, accelerate the transition towards electric vehicles, reduce transport-sector emissions, improve air quality, and facilitate the development of an enabling ecosystem for electric mobility in Punjab. The Policy provides a comprehensive framework for adoption of New Energy Vehicles (NEVs), development of charging and battery-swapping infrastructure, investment facilitation, regulatory reforms, institutional coordination, and environmental sustainability.

3. All Administrative Departments are requested to extend their full cooperation for effective implementation of the Punjab NEV Policy. The Departments are further requested to nominate a focal person, where required, and undertake necessary actions falling within their respective mandates to facilitate implementation of the Policy objectives and interventions.
